

Craigslist.org

In most parts of the country, craigslist.org is being used for Real Estate listings for sale. I like to make sure the listings that I post look better than an average craigslist entry. Craigslist allows html (hypertext markup language) when posting to their site. I add photos and graphics to mine, but you can make your post look better with only a little bit of html.

In order to bold text: `Text to be bolded`

In order to italicize: `<i>Text to be italicized</i>`

In order to add a line break: `
`

In order to make the font one point larger: `Font to be enlarged` (you can also use -1 here, + or - 2, 3, etc).

In order to change the color of the text: `Text to be in color` (You can use most of the basic color names here).

In order to add an image to your craigslist post, you must know where the image is stored on the internet. Here is the code to add an image of mine:

`img src` is the location of the image on the internet.

`align` tells the browser where to align the photograph in the paragraph

`hspace` is horizontal space between image and text (you can use any number here, 5 to 20 is usually best)

`vspace` is vertical space between image and text

Craigslist also allows the use of tables, but I will tackle that in another tutorial. You can always email me to ask for simple html coding or how to accomplish something on the internet. If I don't know how to do what you are asking, chances are I know someone who does.
